

When visiting, remember to follow these key guidelines:

- You must sign in and get your temperature taken at the command center prior to entering the facility
- All visitors and resident will be required to wear a well-fitted mask for the duration of their visit (cloth masks are not permitted) regardless of vaccination status
- Go directly to your loved ones room—stay in the room during the visit.
- Keep a six foot distance from others on your direct path to their room
- Remain in their room during your entire visit (access to dining rooms/community rooms is strictly prohibited)
- Visitation must maintain infection control protocols especially proper wearing of face coverings and physical distancing regardless of resident and visitor's vaccination status
- If a resident's roommate is unvaccinated or immunocompromised, arrangements should be made with nursing to facilitate the visit in a private location outside of the room. If the resident is unable to leave the room, extra precautions should be taken especially physical distancing, wearing face covering at all times and hand sanitation. This may warrant the need to limit the number of visitors at a time.
- No eating or drinking is permitted during visit—please do not visit during meal times.
- Pets are permitted but must remain on leash at all times and be well-behaved
